This product is not recommended for use in pure oxygen and/or oxygen rich systems and should not be selected as a sealant for chlorine or other strong oxidizing materials.

#### **Directions for use**

- 1. Provide adequate ventilation.
- 2. Shut engine off.
- Protect painted surfaces thoroughly from over-spray, as LOCTITE<sup>®</sup> Pro Strength Varnish Remover will attack the paint.
- 4. Shake can thoroughly before use.
- 5. NOTE: This product does not require a ball agitator.
- 6. Best results are obtained when the product is at room temperature.
- 7. Holding can 20 to 25 cm from the surface for open area cleaning, or 12 cm using the extension tube provided for hard to reach areas, press the nozzle and discharge the product on the assembly.
- 8. **Carburetor:** Spray carburetor inside and out covering all parts. Repeat application if necessary.
- 9. Automatic Choke: Mark indicator plate before removing. Spray directly into choke housing on spring and other parts. Repeat application if necessary. Wipe dry. Reinstall parts with indicator plate in original position.

#### Clean-up

1. Clean hands with hand cleaners.
